Our commitment

Vectair Environmental Ltd is publicly committed to achieving Net Zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050 across Scopes 1, 2 and 3.

Approved by our Board of Directors on 1 January 2026, this commitment applies across our operations, the services we deliver and the material supply-chain impacts associated with our work. It also applies directly to the environmental measures we can implement when performing NHS and other client contracts.

How we will deliver it

We will establish and maintain an appropriate greenhouse-gas emissions baseline, identify our material emissions sources, set proportionate reduction actions and review progress at least annually. Our priorities include lower-emission fleet transition and route planning, reduced energy consumption, efficient use of water and chemicals, waste prevention and recycling, responsible purchasing, and engagement with suppliers on material Scope 3 emissions.

We will prioritise measurable emissions reduction within our own operations and value chain. Any future use of high-quality carbon removals or offsets will address residual emissions only and will not substitute for feasible direct reduction.

Governance and publication

The Board of Directors owns this commitment and will oversee the emissions baseline, reduction priorities, progress review and public reporting. We will use operational, fleet, energy, procurement and waste information to improve the quality of our evidence over time. This statement will be reviewed at least annually and updated where our organisational boundary, evidence or delivery plan materially changes.
